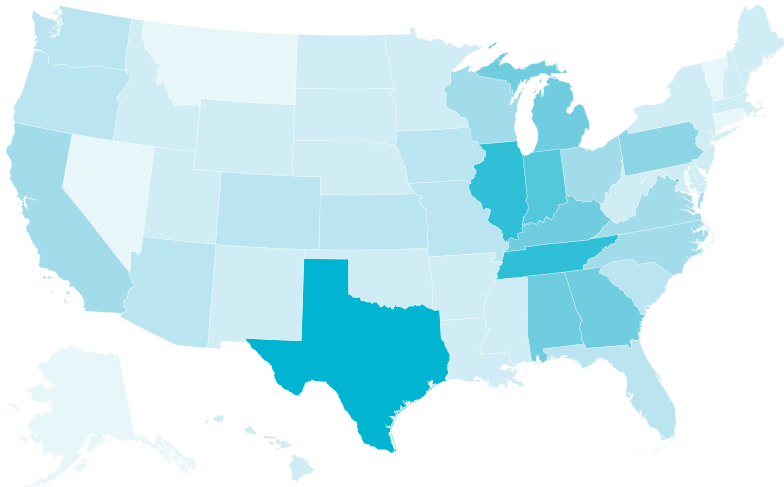

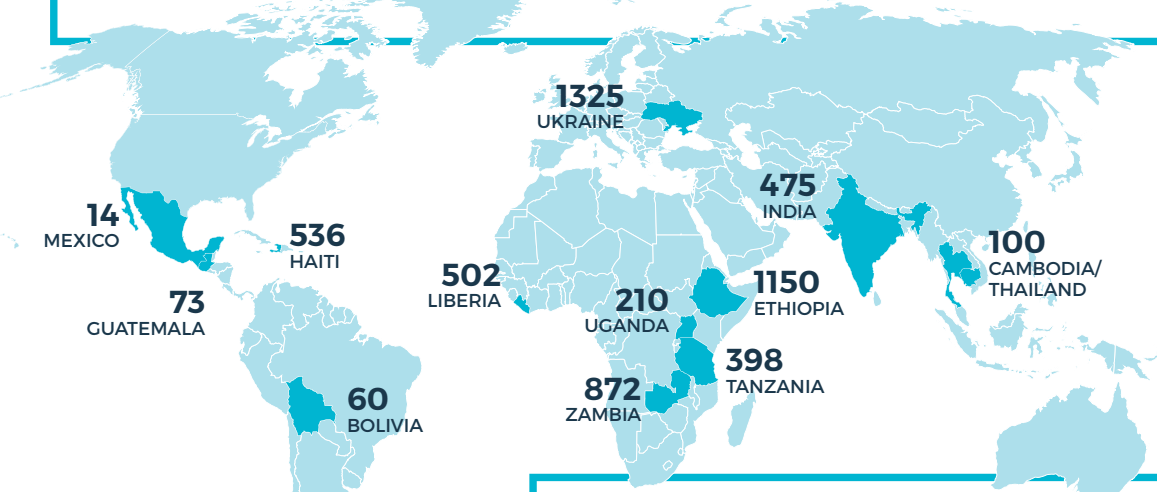

CHRISTIAN NEW SCHOOL HAITI

Lifesong Christian School is in its first year as an educational facility teaching 103 students, 25 of which live in Student Life homes. Mayko, one of the new teachers, says, "When I was in high school, I didn't have the chance to be in a school with electricity, Internet, or extracurriculars. But Lifesong provides all these things for students in the community."



RESTORING HOPE LIBERIA
