POSITION SUMMARY:

The Child and Family Development Director will work to equip assigned Lifesong for Orphans ministry sites in awareness, knowledge, and practical application of trauma-informed best practice, family strengthening, and community development.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assess child and family development needs of each Lifesong international ministry site and serve them as you become aware.
- Assist site directors to identify and develop strong CFDTs to implement best practices in the field.
- Develop effective communication and feedback processes with site staff and site director to support ongoing relationships with leadership, CFDT staff and Interdisciplinary Team Professionals.
- Be an avid learner of all trauma-informed best practice, family strengthening, community development, and related topics. (i.e. trauma, global child welfare, attachment, child development)
- Coach Child Development and Strong Families Teams, along with other related ministry staff or
 ministry partners, before and after training as needed/requested, . (i.e. TBRI parent coaching with
 Student Life House Parents, 4-part pledge goal planning with site directors, trauma competent care
 strategies for children's home directors.)
- Participate in and/or facilitate regular book club discussions.
- Participate in a coaching role in monthly or quarterly Communities of Practice forums.
- Participate in visits to observe how trauma-informed care is being implemented at the site, assess site's trauma-informed practices and policies, provide site-specific identified trainings, and support and train all site CFDT members and all affiliate trainers.
- Develop outcome measurement systems to identify gaps in and progress made with child and family development.
- Integrate Lifesong for Orphans ministry values into all staff interactions with a trauma-informed approach.









SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist in the creation and implementation of curriculums utilized for teaching and growing our sites in Biblical-based trauma-informed family strengthening and community development best practices.
- Conduct regular coaching calls with all assigned staff working through the CFDT training and professional development plan.
- Travel to assigned ministry site as needed to assist with CFDT trainings.

- Experience in the child development or child welfare fields
- Experience as a trainer preferred
- · Professional development coaching or mentoring experience preferred
